

Annual report from the Nordic network "Communicative relations" 2017

The network's general objective is to spread knowledge of the theory behind the book "Communicative relations".

Meetings

June 1th and 2th 2016 in Oslo.

November ^{29th} and 30th 2016 in Gothenburg.

February 8th and 9th 2017 in Aalborg.

The arrangements for the meetings is that the network meet the first day and work together, with an agreed agenda. The second day includes a seminar with video analysis. People in the country hosting the meeting are invited to the seminar. This seminar contributes cooperation between the Nordic and the national networks in the three countries who currently are represented in the network.

Tasks of the network:

* Send an abstract for workshop at the European Conference in September 2017. The network was unfortunately refused.

* Initiative and planning a course at Dronninglund, Denmark, in March 2017. It's a continuation Nordic course through the Nordic Welfare Center where further work on the theories of "Communicative Relations" using. Video analysis.

* Spread awareness of a training course "Communicative Relations. The course is built up for 3x2 days and is carried out in Oslo. Swedish and Danish students are welcome.

* Spread the knowledge of two annual national seminar in Sweden. During the seminar we are working with video analysis regarding to communicative relations.



* Spread awareness of a pilot project that ran in 2016 on CDH in Aalborg. The participants worked with video analysis in study groups. The plan is maybe to arrange a course with the same content as in the pilot project.

In connection to the pilot project, a "guideline" was produced. It is a guiding document that can be used specifically in connection with video analysis based on theories of "Communicative relationships". This was prepared by a team from CDH / Aalborg, and the network has helped to develop this "guideline".

Future plans:

* Arrange a case study/course, where the theories of "Communicative Relations" ensure quality and evidence-based knowledge that is collected in the cases.

* Explore the possibility of a Nordic course in 2018 between Stadped / NKDB / NVC. The network is responsible for the content of the course.

* Writing a description of the network on NVC's website, as well as small ongoing updates/documentation of the academic discussions by the network.
