Stuttering is a communication disability which can exclude people from having same opportunities in the society as people without disabilities have. People who stutter can have fewer opportunities in the labour market, experience social exclusion and suffer for mental illnesses such as anxiety and depression in the result of not feeling the inclusion in the society. The main goal of the World Congress for People Who Stutter is: to prevent social exclusion among people who stutter by providing support from experts as well as through peer support connect people who stutter to create new ideas for improving the equality rights and the acceptance of the people who stutter in the society. The congress consists of workshops of the participants where everyone share their own expertise among other participants. The workshops have been chosen by the World Congress Committee which consists of members of Icelandic Stuttering Association.</p>

The number of characters may not exceed 1000.</p>	<p>Every three years, a world congress for people who stutter takes place. Many of those congresses have been organized through a joint effort between the ISA, the International Stuttering Association, IFA, the International Fluency Association and the national association where it takes place. Unlike many other world congresses for people who stutter, this one is not organized in collaboration by IFA, but solely by ISA and Málbjörg, the National Stuttering Association of Iceland. That makes this congress an event that is not only organized for people who stutter (PWS) but also solely organized BY PWS. While some participants are family members of PWS and/or speech therapists and researchers in the field, most of the participants are PWS. The event is made up of various presentations and workshops that relate to stuttering in different ways. Most of the presenters are PWS themselves. While some of the presentations and workshops revolve around research and therapy, we have required the participants to use simple and clear language to ensure that most PWS can understand what is taking place. The theme of the World Congress is Embrace Your Stuttering and we have made sure to minimize the number of workshops and presentations that revolve around medicalization of stuttering and finding a “cure”. At the same time, Malbjorg has focused on workshops that are organized by PWS for other PWS that revolve around the acceptance of stuttering.</p>
<p>What outputs, outcomes and impacts achieved by the project do you expect?</p>	<p>The World Congress is aiming for to create more networking among people interested in the topic for further collaborations to improve the disability rights for people who stutter and to prevent the social exclusion of PWS in the society. We are expecting participants to learn about stuttering in a broad sense at the congress that they can then bring back to their home countries, their local associations and their everyday lives. The National Stuttering Association of Iceland will reimburse its members partly to participate, with the promise that said members will write about their experience of the congress, make an art piece or otherwise share their experience. We intend to survey participants before the congress about their experience with stuttering in daily life, asking if they are avoiding certain speaking situations, workshops that revolve around speaking, public speaking et cetera. After the congress we plan to do a similar survey and see if their answers have changed. Our hope is that after the congress, they will have increased acceptance of their stuttering, speaking up and speaking their mind.
